Selection must be discussed with and approved by the instructor. The final grade will be based on the given presentation.

Learning outcomes of the course:

The course provides an introduction to the Slovak history and culture covering some of the most important topics, periods and characters from the Slovak culture. The course consists mainly of lectures focusing on various aspects such as Slovak traditions, history, visual arts, literature, media, interesting figures etc. but there will be also field trips to natural and historical sights and a gallery visit. During the course the students will learn more about Slovakia and, as a result, they will better understand Slovak culture and Slovaks.
