**Learning outcomes of the course:**

- is able to apply linguistic and literary knowledge of the historical context to a variety of cultural-artistic and pragmatic-communicative activities,
- is able to keep in touch with current developments in Italian philology and to pursue his/her own professional development effectively,
- is able to professionally present his/her own views on a historical topic, including in a foreign language
- is able to develop his/her own linguistic culture in the Italian language
