Acquisition of communication skills and strategies (listening comprehension, reading comprehension, oral expression, written expression) in order to reach communication level C2 in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

After completing the school subject, the student will acquire the following knowledge, skills and competences:

- the knowledge gained from the subject mainly refers to the acquisition of a wider vocabulary corresponding to the C2 level
- the applicant should achieve communication-type skills, i.e. the ability to understand and correctly understand oral speech in a broad communication context and respond correctly based on the context, and correctly interpret a written text even at an artistic level or a professional text and correctly choose the corresponding stylistic level during written speech .
- through texts from textbooks and real texts from the contemporary press, the student will become familiar with the basic concepts of some sectoral languages such as legal, bureaucratic language, the most used technical terms and rhetorical tropes in contemporary journalism.
- The aim of the subject should be to strengthen the orthoepic, orthographic, phonological, grammatical, lexical and semantic components of language competence at the required level.

Course contents:

Text comprehension, lexical and stylistic analysis, textual analysis of various texts on the topics: youth (intergenerational relations, problems of adolescence, acceptance of authority), employment (migration and immigration, economic crisis, unemployment), the influence of the Internet and social media in society, importance and problematic the use of new means of communication, religion, the injustice of contemporary society, inequality and class differences.
