There is a two-stage selection process. In the first phase, the candidate will be selected based on his research experience, the proposed topic and the quality of the project proposal. In the second phase, the applicant will prepare a detailed project in close cooperation with the host institution, which will be submitted to the call (deadline September 18, 2023).

The fellowship is for a period of 12 to 24 months; the starting date will be in 2024 based on an agreement with the host institution. The work will be financed from the EU project, according to the regulations published in the VAIA call number 09103-03-V04 dated 6/27/2023. Definitive occupation of the position is conditional on the approval of the project; if the project is not approved, the position will not be filled.

The successful candidate will be expected to conduct independent research within the objectives set out in a submitted research project at the Faculty of Theology, Catholic University in Ružomberok, Slovakia.
