Learning outcomes of the course:

Theoretical knowledge:

The student has a knowledge of the urgent medicine, masters cardiopulmonary resusciation, is able to orientate onself in providing of the first aid and in case of the other acute conditions.

Practical skills: to master procedures, the algorithm of the first aid in the sudden states and special situations. To know the law aspects, system and organisation of the first aid.

Course contents:

- 1. The introduction of the subject, the basic terms of the first aid.
- 2. Pre-hospital urgent healthcare.
- 3. The system, organisation, law aspects, and general principles of the firs aid.
- 4. The organisation, technique and protocols of the first aid in case of the mass accidents and special situations (material equipment and show).
- 5. History, phases, grades and procedures of urgent cardiopulmocerebral resuscitation.

- 6. Algorithms of the urgent resuscitation of adults and children.
- 7. The first aid in case of sudden states and training of first aid providing.
- 8. The first aid in the gynecology and obsterics.
- 9. The complications in the CPCR.
- 10. Ethic problems in the resuscitations.
- 11. The most common types of poisoning and the first aid in these cases.
- 12. The antidote and tools.
