The aim of the International Scientific Conference “Burnout Syndrome in the Helping Professions” is to create an interdisciplinary forum where experts from the fields of pedagogy, nursing, medicine, psychology, social work, management and related disciplines will share current scientific knowledge on the etiology, diagnosis, prevalence, prevention and treatment of burnout syndrome, especially in the helping professions (health professionals, social workers, educators, psychologists, clergy, emergency services, etc.).

Topics:

Epidemiology and trends in burnout/workload perception	Prevalence, risk groups, international comparisons, impact of the pandemic, job demands and digitalization of work.
Individual risk and protective factors for burnout	Personality traits, coping strategies, resilience, lifestyle and working with emotional distress.
Diagnosis and measurement of burnout / subjectively perceived strain	Instrument validation, biomarkers of stress, digital screening platforms, ethical issues in assessment.
Clinical and psychosomatic consequences of burnout/workload	Comorbidities (anxiety, depression, PTSD), somatic manifestations, long-term effects on cognitive function and quality of life.
Individual, organisational and systems approaches to addressing burnout	Cognitive-behavioural programmes, mindfulness, existential approaches, coaching, supervision, self-care, workplace mental health policy, workoverload management, etc.
Technology and e-health solutions for burnout	Apps to prevent and monitor burnout, virtual reality for stress management training, AI in screening.

Languages: Slovak, Czech, English

Conference Outcome:

The papers will be published in the peer-reviewed scientific journal FHS CU - [Health Studies](#) (CEEOL, EBSCO, Crossref, CiBaMed, Bibliographia medica Slovaca) or in the peer-reviewed scientific journal PF KU - [Disputationes Scientifcae](#) (CEEOL, Crossref). Instructions for formal editing of the text will be sent to participants after the registration closes, i.e. after the deadline of 25 August 2025.
