The author contributed to the development of the study design, proposed and carried out the method of data collection and processing in the research part, and carried out the statistical processing itself.

**OCA15. - Annotation of the output with contextual information concerning the description of creative process and the content of the research/artistic/other activity, etc.**

The aim of the study is to identify the prevalence of sexting among children and adolescents in Slovakia in 2021 and 2022. The study sample consisted of 1423 children and adolescents in 2021 and 1194 children and adolescents in 2022. Sexting was measured with questions focused on sending and receiving sext messages, the scales were taken from the EU Kids online study. The primary results of the analysis include the finding that in the post-pandemic year (2022) there was a decrease in sexting compared to the pandemic year (2021) at the level of receiving and sending sext messages. Compared to abroad, Slovak children and adolescents do not differ significantly in receiving sext messages, but they differ in sending sext messages, which they send to a lesser extent. Some differences were also observed in terms of gender, age and family type.

**OCA18. - Characteristics of the output's impact on socio-economic practice**

The output of the creative activity contributes to the professional and scientific training not only of students of social work and other helping professions but also to the possibility of solving the situation related to sexting. The research results interpret new empirical findings and enable targeted setting of preventive activities against this negative phenomenon, which can significantly make the prevention process more effective.

The above-mentioned output of creative activity can be used in the educational process on several levels: on the first level, the research results will enrich the previously known knowledge about the phenomenon of sexting in the context of excessive Internet use, and on the second level, the implementation of the research part within the evidence base practice approach will allow us to consider the effective provision of evidence-based intervention at the micro, meso and macro levels of social work practice.

The aim of the study is to identify risk groups among primary school pupils in Slovakia and the Czech Republic in order to develop effective preventive measures in relation to technological addictions. The study, which identifies these groups, uses research and addiction theory by M. Griffiths. The research instrument was based on an original questionnaire consisting of adapted questions, as well as the Internet Overuse Scale. The statistical method of classification trees was used to identify risk groups. Risk factors for Internet use and computer gaming were identified in Slovak respondents: number of hours per day spent on the Internet or playing computer games and passive leisure time; in Czech respondents: style of computer gaming, number of hours per day spent on the Internet or playing computer games, gender, passive leisure time and parental control. The findings can be used to design effective prevention programs for children and adolescents at risk of Internet and computer game addiction, as well as for parents and other professionals involved in eliminating risk factors at all three levels of prevention.

The aim of the presented work is to analyze empirical studies and their methodological characteristics in the journal Sociální práca / Sociálna práca for the period since the beginning of the journal's publication - from 2002 to 2019. In foreign literature, we find several content analyses focused on research in journals in the field of social work. The journal Sociální práca / Sociálna práca has not yet undergone such an analysis. Quantitative content analysis was used as a research technique and categories were created describing the methodological characteristics of the research. The obtained data were evaluated using descriptive statistics. The main findings include: in research studies, qualitative research prevailed over quantitative research; in quantitative studies, the intentional method of selecting the research set prevailed, and in qualitative criteria, the selection method prevailed; Information on the psychometric characteristics of the research instrument was almost non-existent in research studies, and the method of processing and interpretation was dominated by qualitative verbal studies without creating categories, and descriptive and inferential statistics in quantitative studies.
